Note: AFM makes a product that can be used to seal carpets of questionable safety called AFM Carpet Seal (see AFM Enterprises under paints).

These are tolerable to most people with severe sensitivities and can be used for scouring bathrooms, counters, stoves, pots and pans. Lynn Bower suggests using the cleaning cake for windows, and buffing off the film with a cotton cloth before it dries. You might prefer the rectangular container without the synthetic detergent.

Note: R. Bruce McCreary suggests the Standard Trifield Meter with 100X external probe for \$210. This is available direct from Dr. Lee at Alpha Labs only. It is a special modification made available at R. Bruce McCreary's request. This is the only commercially available meter that is sensitive to 0.002 milligauss (2 microgauss). This is slightly more sensitive than almost all ES folks. This meter is for just below power line frequency to 100KHz magnetic fields only. The other modes on this meter (radio and electric) are not sensitive enough to be useful for folks with ES. Bruce sees this meter as essential survival equipment for anyone with MCS or ES. Many people with MCS will find that places that were bothersome from "unsmellable" chemicals are in fact high magnetic field locations.
